The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Respondent No.2 has alleged that the Petitioner has committed an offence punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for brevity, 'the I.P.C.,') and Sections 123 and 125 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (for brevity, 'the R.P Act'), in connection with Marripadu Police Station. It is observed that for an offence punishable under Section 188 of 'the I.P.C.,' the Court can take cognizance only upon a proper complaint made by a public servant, as mandated under Section 195 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'the Cr.P.C.,'). In view of the above, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C. No.15 of 2026 on the file of the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Udayagiri, SPSR Nellore District, until the next date of hearing.
