The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Petitioner/Accused No.2 is the mother-in-law of Respondent No.2. The Petitioners/Accused Nos.3 and 4 are the brother-in-law and sister-in-law of Petitioner/Accused No.2, and they are residing separately. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Ms. Umadevi Manchala, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on	Contd...

07.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

List this Criminal Petition along with Crl.P.No.3305 of 2026.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.03 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Atmakur.
