The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner by Respondent No.2, which are compoundable and punishable with imprisonment of less than seven years, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr. Ch. Veera Venkata Satyanarayana, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on	Contd...

08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the presence of Petitioner/Accused No.3 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless his presence is otherwise required.
