(under section 482 of Cr.P.C), praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the entire proceedings in Charge sheet in C.C. No.300 of 2019 on the file of the Court of the learned Special Judicial First-Class Magistrate for Railways, Guntur, Guntur District based on the FIR in Crime No.521 of 2014 of Arundalpet Police Station, Guntur, dated 21-08-2014 against the Petitioner/ A-3 for the offences punishable U/ Secs. 420 R/w-34 of I.P.C.;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PERAM NRUSIMHA PAVAN KUMAR, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against the Petitioner/ A-3 in C.C. No.300 of 2019 on the file of the Court of the learned Special Judicial First-Class Magistrate for Railways, Guntur, Guntur District based on the FIR in Crime No.521 of 2014 of Arundalpet Police Station, Guntur, dated 21-08-2014 against the Petitioner/ A-3 for the offences punishable U/ Secs.420 R/w 34 of I.P.C., pending disposal of CRLP No. 3345 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following ORDER:**

**Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to respondent No.2.**

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner by Respondent No.2, which are compoundable and punishable with imprisonment of less than seven years, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Ch. Veera Venkata Satyanarayana, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the presence of Petitioner/Accused No.3 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless his presence is otherwise required.
