WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri HANUMANTHA RAO BACHINA, presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records pertaining to FIR No.6/2026 dated 07.01.2026 on the file of Gudivada I Town Police Station, Krishna District and quash the same in the interests of justice, further Direct the de-facto complainant to participate in arbitration proceedings as provided under Clause 2 of the Master Franchisee Agreement dated 02.09.2025;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri HANUMANTHA RAO BACHINA, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including the arrest of the Petitioner in FIR No.6/2026 dated 07.01.2026 on the file of Gudivada I Town Police Station, Krishna District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3340 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Ms.Koppaka Aruna, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
