WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri THANJAVURU VENKATA SUMAN presented this Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the proceedings in C.C.No. 1175 of 2023 on the file of the Court of the I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa, arising out of Crime No.129 of 2023 of Kadapa I Town U.G. Police Station, registered for the alleged offences under Sections 406, 420 R/w 34 I PC insofar as the Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 3 are concerned, as the continuation of the said proceedings is nothing but an abuse of process of law

and would result in grave prejudice and irreparable injury to the Petitioners, and consequently;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri THANJAVURU VENKATA SUMAN Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for R1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted on or before summer vacation, 2026.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay all further proceedings, including the personal appearance of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 3 in C.C.No.1175 of 2023 on the file of the Court of the I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa, arising out of Crime No.129 of 2023 of Kadapa I Town U.G. Police Station, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3336 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The presence of the Petitioners is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court unless it is otherwise required.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Kanagala Radhika, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
