The Court made the following Common Order:*(per Hon'ble Sri Justice R. Raghunandan Rao)*

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that, these three Writ Petitions can be disposed of, in terms of the interim directions of the erstwhile High Court of Andhra Pradesh, dated 28.04.2011.

2. The learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents, would also submit that, connected matters, had been disposed of, by the erstwhile High Court of Andhra Pradesh, by its order, dated 19.08.2009, in W.P.No.23451 of 2008 & batch.

3. In these circumstances, these Writ Petitions are disposed of, in the following manner:

"In view of the policy decision taken by the Government pursuant to the recommendations of PRC, 1999, towards advance increments for higher qualifications granted with effect from 1.7.1998, we are not inclined to interfere with the decision taken by the Government. But, however, we direct that the amounts already paid up to 17.3.2007, towards advance increment/family planning incentive increments shall not be recovered from the employees. Further it is made clear that from 17.3.2007 if any advance increments are granted to the employees, the Government is at liberty to recover the same."

There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, interlocutory applications pending, if any shall stand closed.
