Dr.YLR,J <u>CrI.P.No.3339 of 2026</u> Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Issue notice to respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The petitioners are the in-laws of Respondent No.2. After Accused No.1 filed a petition for restitution of conjugal rights, Respondent No.2 lodged a complaint against the petitioners, which was registered as Crime No.226 of 2024 on the file of the Station House Officer, Chilakaluripet. Respondent No.2 alleges that, in the month of December 2022, she was necked out by the petitioners and her husband after being beaten, as she could not meet the unlawful demands of the petitioners. However, Respondent No.2 lodged the	Contd...

complaint on 04.10.2024, nearly two years later. Of course, the offence defined under Section 85 of 'the BNS' is continuous in nature.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners by Respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Habeeb Sheik, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.78 of 2025 on the file of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Chilakaluripet.
