The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Petitioner/Accused No.2 suffered grievous injuries; therefore, he lodged a complaint, which was registered as Crime No.274 of 2025, as per the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner. It is further submitted that Respondent No.2 suffered only simple injuries in the alleged attack and lodged a complaint with the Station House Officer, Kovvuru, which was registered as Crime No.273 of 2025 for the offence punishable under Section 118(1) read with Section 3(5) of 'the BNSS'. 		Respondent No.2 and the petitioner, respectively. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that, in the counter-case lodged by the petitioner, the petitioner suffered only simple injuries and not grievous injuries. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr. Arrabolu Sai Naveen, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The learned Mediator shall conduct the mediation not only in the present case but also in Crime No.274 of 2025. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report. Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further	Contd...
