WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri Seshagiri Rao Ullam presented this Petition under Section 582 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the petitioners in CC.no.1019 of 2025 in Crime no. 47 of 2025 on the file of the Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division) at Mangalagiri, lodged under section 118(1) r/w 3(5)BNS;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Seshagiri Rao Ullam, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Public Prosecutor

for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

be and hereby are directed to show cause, either appearing in person or through Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners in CC.no.1019 of 2025 in Crime no. 47 of 2025 on the file of the Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division) at Mangalagiri, lodged under section 118(1) r/w 3(5) BNS, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3341 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed a suit in O.S.No.37 of 2025 for recovery of an amount of Rs.30,00,000/-. It is further submitted that the banana crop of the petitioners was subjected to mischief by Respondent No.2.

In that regard, the petitioners also lodged a complaint against Respondent No.2, which was registered as Crime No.269 of 2024, as per the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the alleged offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Ch. Veera Ventkata Satyanarayana, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1019 of 2025 on the file of the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mangalagiri."
