Dr.YLR,J <u>CrI.P.No.3347 of 2026</u> Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Issue notice to the Respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Respondent No.2 alleges that the Petitioners has committed not only the offence of criminal breach of trust but also the offence of cheating. The Hon'ble Apex Court in Delhi Race Club (1940) Ltd v. State of Uttar Pradesh¹ observed that the criminal breach of trust and cheating cannot go together. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr.Bethapalli Surya Narayana, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in

	that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation. The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator’s report. Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.2412 of 2021 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, NTR District.
