The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the complaint was submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Kurnool, and duly acknowledged by the office of the Superintendent of Police. However, no action was taken on the complaint against Respondent No.2, who has indulged in other illegal activities, including causing mischief to the Petitioner's mobile phone, demanding the Petitioner and the tempo travel driver to pay Rs.10,000/-, and foisting a false case against a traveler who came from Karnataka to visit several places, including temples in Andhra Pradesh, as part of a pilgrimage. Having regard to the allegations leveled by Respondent No.2 against the Petitioner, and also to the complaint submitted by the Petitioner, who is a practicing advocate in the State of Karnataka, before the Superintendent of Police,	

		Kurnool, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1054 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Adoni. The Superintendent of Police, Kurnool, shall submit a report regarding the action taken on the complaint lodged by the Petitioner against the Respondent No.2, dated 12.09.2025.
