The Court made the following

ORDER:

This contempt case is filed against the respondents for willful disobedience of the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.14097 of 2024, dated 17.09.2025. The operative portion of the said order is extracted hereunder:

“.....this Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the admitted amount of Rs.2,73,18,241.35/- to the petitioner within a period of six (06) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order....”

2. Today when the matter came up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the respondents/contemnors furnished a copy of Letter No.FIN01-FMU0MISC/350/2022(1778130), dated 31.07.2026, issued by the 1st respondent, wherein it is stated that the amounts payable to the petitioner i.e., an amount of Rs.59,53,707/- vide Bill No.2026-7412182 and Rs.2,15,66,380/- vide Bill No.2026-7412180, were cleared on 31.07.2026. Therefore, requested this Court to close the contempt case.

3. Recording the above, the Contempt Case is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this case shall stand closed.
