Issue notice to the respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on the respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The arrears of maintenance of Rs.2,90,000/-, as admitted by both the parties, shall be paid by the Petitioner to Respondent No. 2 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

In the event of non-payment of the arrears, the learned Trial Court shall be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law against the petitioner.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026.
