Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th respondent not to dispossess the petitioner from the land in Sy.No.347-3D an extent of Ac.2.50 cents situated in Kanaganapalli village and mandal, Sri Satyasai Dist., pending disposal of this writ petition and pass any such other orders or orders as the Honble court feel deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case in the interests of Justice.

The Court made the following Order:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents.

2. This writ petition is filed questioning the action of the 4th respondent in trying to dispossess the petitioner from the land in Sy.No.347-3D in an extent of Ac.2.50 cents situated in Kanaganapalli Village and Mandal, Sri Satyasai District.

3. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue relying upon the written instructions of the 4th respondent dated 30.04.2026 submits that the land in Sy.No.347-3D in an extent of Ac.2.50 cents of Kanaganapalli Village is a Government land and has not been assigned to the petitioner under any valid procedure.

4. However, both the learned counsels submit that the similar matter is already disposed of by this court in W.P.No.11738 of 2026 dated 29.04.2026.

5. In terms of the same, this writ petition is also disposed of, directing the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to deal with the subject land in an extent of Ac.2.50 cents in Sy.No.347-3D situated in Kanaganapalli Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, strictly in accordance with law, if so warranted and if so required for any public purpose. If the petitioner is otherwise found to be in possession of the same, she shall be dealt with strictly in accordance with law, by hearing all the parties concerned, including the petitioner, giving due

opportunity, upon verification of the records and the subject land, appropriate decision shall be taken on its own merits. Any dispossession from the subject land shall not be made except by following the due process of law. Interim order if any deemed to have been vacated. There shall be no order as to costs. The said written instructions of the 4th respondent dated 30.04.2026 shall be made as part of the Court record.

6. The Registry is directed to append the copy of the order passed in W.P.No.11738 of 2026 dated 29.04.2026 to this order.

As a sequel, Interlocutory Applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
