The petition/Appeal coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of N SIVA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent no 1 and of SRI.JOSYULA BHASAKARA RAO Advocate for Respondent No. 2, and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Petitioner No.1 is working as Major in Indian Army. Because of the bickering arose in between Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2, they are living separately. Petitioner No.1 has filed a divorce petition in one of the Courts in Chennai.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Respondent No.2 has approached the Hon'ble Apex Court seeking for transfer of divorce proceedings pending in one of the Courts in Chennai to Kakinada but no favourable orders were passed in favour of Respondent No.2.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri P.Mohana Rao, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

Both the parties shall attend the mediation either physically or virtually as per their convenience for amicable settlement on 07.05.2026.

For mediator's report, post after three weeks.
