ORDER:-

The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is against the action of the respondents in restricting the contract period to six (6) months, contrary to Circular Memo dated 24.03.2026 and G.O.Rt.No.4271 dated 01.11.2008.

2. It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that after filing of the writ petition, the respondents have extended the contract period for another six (6) months. Thus, he submits that no further orders are required to be passed.

3. In view of the same, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall also stand closed.
