Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioner in CC.No.784 of 2025 on the file of the I Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Tenali, Guntur District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3370 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Petitioner No.1 is the brother of Accused No.1, and Petitioner No.2 is the wife of Petitioner No.1.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. D.Kishore Kumar, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue proceedings in that regard. necessary

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.No.2585 of 2026 under the caption 'Part Heard'.

Post the matter after five weeks, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C. No.784 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Tenali, Guntur District, with regard to the petitioners/Accused Nos.4 and 5 only.
