Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.15/2026 on the file of Mahila UPS, Visakhapatnam Commissionerate, Visakhapatnam District including arrest of the petitioner/Accused No.4., pending disposal of CRLP No. 3394 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Petitioner/Accused No.4 is the sister of Accused No.1 and the sister-in-law of respondent No.2.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of the allegations leveled against the petitioner by respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Jyothi Lakshmi Midhipati, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.15 of 2026 on the file of Mahila Urban Police Station, Visakhapatnam.
