The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.No.3366 of 2026. The learned trained Mediator shall conduct the mediation in both the matters.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in FIR.No.30 of 2026 on the file of Ipuru Police Station.
