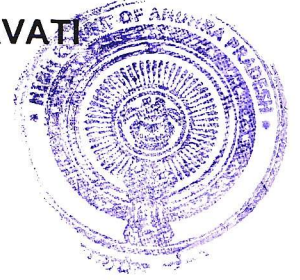

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The presence of the Petitioner/Accused is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless his presence is otherwise required.

The learned IV Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vijayawada, is directed to appoint a trained mediator, if available in Vijayawada, and to refer the parties to mediation.

The appointed mediator shall submit a report to the learned Trial Court on or before 07.05.2026.
