Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or direction declaring the action of the respondents in trying to alter/ delete the Petitioner's

revenue records for land measuring to an extent of 8.8200 Acres in Sy.No.539-1 pursuant to the notice issued vide R.C.No.84/B /2026, Dated 25.02.2026 and Form 15 notice under the pretext of re-survey land as illegal, arbitrary, one without jurisdiction, contrary to law, oppose to Principles of natural Justice and also in utter violation of Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside the same.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to alter, delete, or interfere with the Petitioner's revenue records for 8.8200 Acres in Sy.No.539-1 pursuant to impugned notice issued by the 4th Respondent in R.C.No.84/B /2026, Dated: 25.02.2026 and Form 15 notice under the pretext of re-survey, Pending disposal of WP No.11206 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
