The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioner/Accused No.2 are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years. In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to comply with the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar¹, and also with the provisions of Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNSS'). However, the petitioner is directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer,	Contd...

and the Investigating Officer may proceed with the further investigation. In the course of investigation, if it is noticed that the petitioner has committed any offence punishable with imprisonment beyond seven years, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
