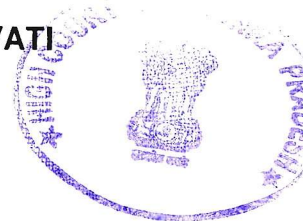

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K B SOLOMON RAJ, Advocate for the Appellant, directed issue of notice to the Respondent herein to show cause as to why this CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS APPEAL should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS APPEAL should not be admitted, on or before 08.07.2026, on which date the case stands posted for hearing.

Petition under Order 41 Rule 5 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay the operation of the order and decree passed in D.O.P.37 of 2022 on the file of the learned PRINCIPAL DISTRICT JUDGE, ANANTHAPURAMU, dated 02.04.2026, pending disposal of CMA No. 282 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

"This appeal has been filed by the appellant/wife being aggrieved from the decree of divorce granted on the petition of the respondent/husband under Section 10(1)(ix) and (a) of the Indian Divorce Act, 1869, vide order and decree dated 02.04.2026, passed in D.O.P.No.37 of 2022 on the file of the learned Principal District Judge, Ananthapuramu.

- 2. Heard the learned counsel for the appellant.**
- 3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the finding on the points of cruelty and desertion in favour of the respondent against the appellant suffers from perversity and cannot be sustained.**
- 4. Issue notice to the respondent.**
- 5. In addition to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent by Registered**

Post and Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry before the next date of listing.

6. Post on 08.07.2026.

7. Considering the submissions advanced, as also the consequences vide from the divorce decree, the operation of the decree dated 02.04.2026, passed in D.O.P.No.37 of 2022 on the file of the learned Principal District Judge, Ananthapuramu, shall remain stayed.

8. The parties shall not remarry.

9. After the appearance of the respondent, the Court will consider to refer the parties to the mediation centre for making efforts for amicable settlement."
