Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.1 and 2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent Nos.1 and 2 and file proof to that effect.

The presence of the Petitioner/Accused dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless his presence is otherwise required.

Considering the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Pitani Chandrasekhar Reddy, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent Nos.1 and 2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.
