01.	24.04.2026	<u>Dr.YLR,J</u> Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Issue notice to respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 9 are government employees. Even in the statement of L.W.1 or in his complaint, there are no specific overt acts attributed to the petitioners. Of course, the de facto complainant and other witnesses have stated that the petitioners, along with other accused, came to the house of one of the victims. The Investigating Officer has filed a charge sheet against the petitioners stating that they have committed offences punishable under Sections 323, 506, and 509 read with Section 34 of 'the IPC'. There are altogether eleven accused in this case. The Investigating Officer has not filed the charge sheet under Section 149 of 'the IPC', nor has he stated that the petitioners formed an unlawful assembly and committed the offence.	Contd...

In the above facts and circumstances of the case, and considering that the alleged offences are punishable with imprisonment of less than seven years, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Ravi Kiran Kumar Kolusu, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.649 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Badvel.
