Respondent No.2 and Accused No.1 got married on 01.07.2019, and they were blessed with one daughter. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Sri Deevi Vara Prasad, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1853 of 2021 on the file of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Piler.
