AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Varadam Sai Likhith, Advocate for the Petitioners and Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings, including the appearance of the petitioners in C.C.No.1853/2021 on the file of Court of Additional Junior Civil Judge Piler, pending disposal of CRLP No.3427 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint against her husband, as well as the in-laws and relatives of her husband, alleging that they have committed the offence of cruelty and harassment as defined under Section 498-A of 'the IPC'.

Respondent No.2 and Accused No.1 got married on 01.07.2019, and they were blessed with one daughter.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Deevi Vara Prasad, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1853 of 2021 on the file of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Piler.
