Respondent No.2 has alleged that the petitioners have committed offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 of 'the IPC'. As per the judgments of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Delhi Race Club (1940) Ltd. v. State of U.P.,¹, and Arshad Neyaz Khan v. State of Jharkhand², Sections 409 and 420 of 'the IPC' would not go together. Considering the entire facts and circumstances	Contd...

of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Gathala Raja Sree, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.649 of 2025 on the file of the learned II Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Tadepalligudem.
