No. 46 of 2026, dated 17.04.2026, on the file of Nadendla Police Station, Palnadu District, for the offences punishable under Section 137(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1 is the wife of the de facto complainant and petitioner Nos. 2 to 8 are relatives of petitioner No. 1. There are matrimonial disputes between petitioner No. 1 and the de facto complainant, while children were	

		proceeded with petitioner No. 1 on the occasion of vacation, the de facto complainant/husband lodged a false case of kidnapping; thus, the case is liable to be quashed. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that there is prima facie material to lodge F.I.R. against the petitioners. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and upon considering the entire aspect, it appears that there is prima facie justification to entertain the present Criminal Petition. Accordingly, the present Criminal Petition is admitted. Issue notice upon Respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. In the mean time the authorities shall not take any coercive steps regarding arrest of the petitioners until further orders. List the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026. SS, J SSA	
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
