Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and upon considering the entire aspect, it appears that there is prima facie justification to entertain the present Criminal Petition. Accordingly, the present Criminal Petition is admitted. Issue notice upon Respondent No.1. The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on	

		Respondent No.1 and file proof to that effect. <u>I.A.No.01 of 2026</u> This is an application to stay of all further proceedings and for dispensing personal appearance of the petitioners before the learned Trial Court. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it appears that Accused Nos.2 to 5 are the in-laws allegations in the F.I.R against the present petitioners are general and omnibus. Considering the same, I think to pass appropriate order. Hence, the learned Magistrate is directed to proceed with the matter according to law. So far as personal appearance of the petitioners/A2 to A5 is concerned, the same may be dispensed with till their appearance before the learned Magistrate for the purpose of framing of charge, examination under section 313 Cr.P.C. and as and when learned Trial Court requires their personal appearance for the reasons stated therein by way of specific order.
