The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

This is an application to stay of all further proceedings and for dispensing personal appearance of the petitioners before the learned Trial Court. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it appears that Accused Nos.2 to 5 are the in-laws allegations in the F.I.R against the present petitioners are general and omnibus.

Considering the same, I think to pass appropriate order. Hence, the learned Magistrate is directed to proceed with the matter according to law. So far as personal appearance of the petitioners/A2 to A5 is concerned, the same may be dispensed with till their appearance before the learned Magistrate for the purpose of framing of charge, examination under section 313 Cr.P.C. and as and when learned Trial Court requires their personal appearance for the reasons stated therein by way of specific order.
