The Court made the following: **ORDER**

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the parents of Accused No.1. There is a love affair between Accused No.1 and Respondent No.2.

Considering and the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and also the law laid down by the Hon’ble Apex Court in Amol Bhagwan Nehul v. State of Maharashtra¹, Kunal Chatterjee v. State of West Bengal², Bhawar Singh v. State of Madhya Pradesh³, Mahesh Damu Khare v. State of Maharashtra⁴ and Rajnish Singh v. State of U.P⁵, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ch.Veera Venkata Satyanarayana, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator’s report.
