01.	28.04.2026	<u>SS,J</u> <u>CRL.P.No.3482 of 2026</u> The instant Criminal Petition is filed for quashing a proceeding being Crime No.12 of 2026, dated 02.03.2026, on the file of Simhadripuram police station, YSR Kadapa District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 351(2), 351(4) r/w 3(5) BNS. The present petitioners are arrayed as accused Nos.1 and 2. The learned counsel for petitioners submits that the disputes between the parties are civil in nature. There is an agreement of sale between the parties to sell out the land. The allegations in the FIR are omnibus and concocted. There is no such incident happened as stated in the FIR. Thus, they filed the instant application for quashing the FIR. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that without ascertaining the allegations in the complaint, it is not possible to enlighten this Court. Having heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for parties it appears that the FIR reflects some civil disputes between the parties, consequently, I think it fit to admit the present Criminal Petition. Accordingly, the present Criminal Petition is admitted.
