WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused No.1 and 2 above named through their Advocate Sri SHAIK MOHAMMED ISMAIL presented this Petition under Sections 528 of BNSS/482 of Cr.P.C., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in F.I.R.No.12 of 2026, dated 02.03.2026 on the file of Simhadripuram Police Station, YSR (Kadapa) District and quash the same;

The Court made the following: ORDER

The instant Criminal Petition is filed for quashing a proceeding being Crime No.12 of 2026, dated 02.03.2026, on the file of Simhadripuram police station, YSR Kadapa District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 351(2), 351(4) r/w 3(5) BNS. The present petitioners are arrayed as accused Nos.1 and 2.

The learned counsel for petitioners submits that the disputes between the parties are civil in nature. There is an agreement of sale between the parties to sell out the land. The allegations in the FIR are omnibus and concocted. There is no such incident happened as stated in the FIR. Thus, they filed the instant application for quashing the FIR.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that without ascertaining the allegations in the complaint, it is not possible to enlighten this Court.

Having heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for parties it appears that the FIR reflects some civil disputes between the parties, consequently, I think it fit to admit the present Criminal Petition. Accordingly, the present Criminal Petition is admitted.

Issue notice upon respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof of service to that effect.
