The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator during the Summer Vacation or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is directed to produce the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.No.3344 of 2026. The learned Mediator shall conduct the mediation in both the matters.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Crime No.22 of 2026 on the file of Hindupur I Town Police Station.
