WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI SANAPALA SAI ROOPESH, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the 2nd Respondent in not considering the petitioners representation dated 05.03.2025 and in failing to prevent the illegal interference of the unofficial respondents with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of the schedule property situated at Edadam Village, Payakaraopeta Mandal, Anakapalle District, as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Articles 14, 19(1)(g), and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondent authorities to extend necessary protection to the petitioner for carrying on aquaculture/shrimp farming activities in the schedule property without obstruction, and to take appropriate action against the unofficial respondents or any third parties;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SANAPALA SAI ROOPESH, Advocate for the Petitioner, learned GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1&2 directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.3 to 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
