WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri I.M.S PRAKASH presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/accused No. 2 to 5 in C.C.No.96 of 2022 on the file of Junior Civil Judge, Vinukonda which arose out of Cr.No.27/2022 of Vinukonda Town Police Station, Guntur District;

IA NO: 2 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.2 to 5 including their appearance in C.C. No. 96 of 2022 on the file of Junior Civil Judge, Vinukonda which arose out of Cr.No. 27/2022 of Vinukonda Town Police Station, Guntur District, pending disposal of CRLP No.3503 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.1.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.1 and file proof to that effect.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Gudiseva Hara Gopal, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the presence of Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to 5 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless their presence is otherwise required.
