No.38 of 2026, dt.09.04.2026, of Dhone Town Police Station, Nandyala District. Heard learned counsel for the parties. The same is considered and allowed. <u>CRL.P. No.3527 OF 2026</u> The petitioner is an Advocate of this Court who was arrayed as an accused in F.I.R. No.38 of 2026 dt.09.04.2026 of Dhone Town Police Station, Nandyal District, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 351(3) and 351(1)(b) of BNS. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that both the offences are non-cognizable. Thus the police authorities should not register F.I.R. Learned counsel further submits that entire allegations in the F.I.R. are false and concocted. The de-facto complainant is not the aggrieved	

	person, thereby the F.I.R. registered against the present petitioner is liable to be quashed. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the investigating authority has already taken permission from the jurisdictional Magistrate to investigate the matter. He further submits that there are certain material to be placed before this Court. Accordingly, he seeks time to enlighten the court. Heard learned counsel for the parties. It appears there are prima facie sufficient reason to entertain the criminal petition, hence the same is admitted. Issue notice to the 2nd respondent/ de facto complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the 2nd respondent by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry after summer vacation 2026. <u>I.A. No.2 of 2026</u> This is an application for stay of all further proceedings of F.I.R. No.38 of 2026, dt.09.04.2026, of Dhone Town Police Station, Nandyala District. Heard learned counsel for the parties. The police authority is at liberty to proceed with the investigation in F.I.R. No.38 of 2026 of	
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		Dhone Town Police Station, Nandyala District, but they shall not take any coercive action against the petitioner till further orders. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of. <u>SS, J</u> BV	
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
