Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to Issue a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondent No. 3 to 5 in subjecting the petitioner to custodial torture as illegal and unconstitutional. Direct registration of FIR against the 6th respondent Sub-Inspector of Police, Meliyaputti Police Station. Direct an independent

investigation by an agency such as CBCID or any other independent authority. And direct to protection to the petitioner from further harassment, and award compensation to the petitioner for custodial torture and violation of fundamental rights;

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to protection to the petitioner from further harassment, and award compensation to the petitioner for custodial torture and violation of fundamental, Pending disposal of WP 12193 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri UMASANKAR LOKANADHAM Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME for Respondent Nos.1 to 6 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Mr. Uma Shankar Lokanadham, learned counsel for the Petitioner, submits that the Petitioner has been subjected to custodial torture by Respondent No.6.

The photographs of the Petitioner reveals that he sustained severe injuries at the hands of Respondent No.6.

Therefore, Respondent No.6 is directed to appear before this Court on 08.05.2026.
