Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S./Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for records and Quash the F.I.R. No.59 of 2026 has been registered The File of Yemmiganur Town Police Station - At Yemmiganur Town, Kurnool District on date:- 16-04-2026 for the offence punishable under Section 74, 75(1)(i), 351(2), 79 of B.N.S.

The petition/Appeal coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI R.NAVEEN KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR Advocate for the Respondent No..1 & 2 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

“The petitioner was arrayed as a sole accused in F.I.R. No.59 of 2026 of Yemmiganur Town Police Station, Kurnool District, dated 16.04.2026, for the offences punishable under Section 74, 75(1)(i), 351(2), 79 of B.N.S.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the 2nd respondent/ de-facto complainant has taken loan from the petitioner instead of repaying the loan amount, to evade the loan amount, instant F.I.R. was lodged. Learned counsel further submits that entire allegations in the F.I.R. are false and concocted. Furthermore, F.I.R. was lodged in delay of 12 days after the alleged incident. Accordingly, the F.I.R. is liable to be quashed.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the 1st respondent/ State submits that there are sufficient material in the F.I.R. against the present petitioner to substantiate the alleged offence.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties it appears the matter cannot be decided without hearing the 2nd respondent/ de-facto complainant. The State shall take notice upon the de facto complainant through the Station House Officer concerned apprising her right of representation before the Court through the Legal Services Authority.

The petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice upon the 2nd respondent/ de facto complainant through registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the registry after summer vacation 2026.”
