It appears that that without hearing of respondent No.2 order of stay cannot be granted. I.A.No.02 of 2026 shall be heard along with Criminal Petition. <u>CRL.P.No.3551 of 2026</u> Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a civil suit in O.S. No. 140 of 2025 is pending before the learned Junior Civil Judge, Darsi, for declaration and permanent injunction in respect of civil disputes between the parties. An order of	

		stay has been granted by the learned Junior Civil Judge, Darsi. Thereafter, the de facto complainant filed the present crime based on a false and frivolous complaint. She seeks to quash the proceedings in Crime No. 35 of 2025 on the file of Thallur Police Station, Prakasam District. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the allegations in the complaint are well-founded and that there is sufficient material to proceed with the matter. Having heard the learned counsel for both parties, it appears that though a civil suit is pending in respect of the subject disputes, since the matter involves allegations of forgery, the criminal proceedings can be maintained. However, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is necessary to hear Respondent No. 2 to properly decide the issue. Issue notice upon Respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect before Registry.
