

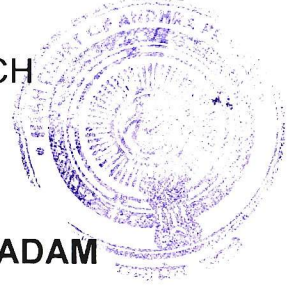

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 4th respondent/Tahsildar in issuing house site patta vide DK No. 2/12 to the 5th respondent with respect Plot No. 72/A which was already assigned to the petitioner's mother in the year 2010 vide DK No. 11/2010 as being illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable and violative of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of

the petitioner over the Plot No. 72/A covered by Sy.Nos. 147/2 and 148/A1 of Medikonduru Village and Mandal, Guntur District without following due process of law.

IA NO: 1 OF 2019

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th respondent/Tahsildar not to interfere or dispossess the petitioner from the house site bearing Plot No. 72/A in Sy.Nos. 147/2 and 148/A1 of Medikonduru Village and Mandal, Guntur District without following due process of law, Pending disposal of WP 10153 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated:29.07.2019 & 26.02.2020 and upon hearing the arguments of SRI G KRISHNA MURTHY, Advocate for the Petitioner, learned GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, the Court made the following

ORDER:

The petitioner and the unofficial respondent No.5 are claiming house plot bearing No.72/A in Sy.Nos.147/2 and 148/A1 of Medikonduru Village and Mandal, Guntur District.

The learned counsel for the 5th respondent submits that earlier she filed W.P. No.36328 of 2018, which was disposed of on 08.10.2018 with an observation that if the writ petitioner was in possession, she shall not be dispossessed from the subject land.

Subsequently, it appears that the unofficial respondent has filed another Writ Petition No.2825 of 2019 and the same is pending before this Court.

In view of the same, the Registry is directed to verify and post W.P. No.2825 of 2019 along with the present Writ Petition.

Post both the matters on 20.04.2026.

In the meantime, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue is directed to obtain instructions as to how the 4th respondent – Tahsildar has issued house site plot bearing No.72/A in Sy.Nos.147/2 and 148/1 to the petitioner as well as to the unofficial respondent. Failing which, the 2nd respondent – District Collector, Guntur District, shall appear before this Court on that date.

The Registry is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the 2nd respondent as well as the 3rd respondent
