WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused 1 & 2 above named through their Advocate SRI M R K CHAKRAVARTHY presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the Spl.SC.No.14/2026 (FIR.No.294/2025 dated 16.12.2025, Kuppam Urban Police Station, Kuppam), on the file of 1st Additional District and

Sessions Judge, Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh by setting aside the Order dated 02.04.2026 taking cognizance and issuing process to the Petitioner

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M R K CHAKRAVARTHY Advocate for the Petitioners, ASSISTANT PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

G Nandini, W/o. V.Nagaraju, Aged about 40 years, Occ Housewife, R/o. Surendra Buildings, Chinnakurlapalli, Kuppam Municipality, Chittoor District.

Are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith(copy enclosed) this **CRIMINAL PETITION** should not be admitted.

The Court made the following order:

“Petitioners are arrayed as Accused Nos. 1 and 2 in Special S.C. No. 14 of 2026 (corresponding to F.I.R. No. 294 of 2025 dated 16.12.2025 on the file of Kuppam Urban Police Station) on the file of the I Additional District & Sessions Judge, Chittoor, for the offences punishable under Section 351(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Sections 3(1)I and 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Petitioner No. 1 is an Advocate who issued a legal notice on behalf of his client, i.e., Petitioner No. 2. He further submits that the facts stated in the F.I.R. are false and concocted, which would be evident from the documents placed on record in the present Criminal Petition.

He further submits that the learned Court below has mechanically taken cognizance of the offences against the present petitioners without

proper application of judicial mind. Consequently, the Special S.C. case is liable to be quashed.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the allegations in the F.I.R. are substantiated by the statements of witnesses recorded during the course of investigation, and that the learned Trial Court has taken cognizance on the basis of the charge sheet.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it appears that Respondent No. 2, being the de facto complainant, is required to be heard in accordance with the provisions of law.

Issue notice to Respondent No. 2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to Respondent No. 2 and file proof thereof before the Registry."
