ORDER

It appears that the de facto complainant had earlier approached jurisdictional Magistrate against his grievances. Furthermore, execution proceedings of jurisdictional civil courts in progress.

At this juncture, it appears, prima facie, the complaint lodged against the present petitioners is doubtful. In my view, if further proceedings in Special S.C. No. 14 of 2026 are not stayed, the petitioners shall suffer irreparable injury.

Accordingly, this Court deems it is necessary to stay all the proceedings in Special S.C.No.14 of 2026 pending before the learned 1st Additional District & Sessions Judge, Chittoor until further orders.

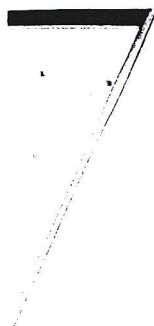
