01.	29.04.2026	<u>SS,J</u> <u>Crl.P.No.3561 of 2026</u> The Petitioner is arrayed as Accused in Cr.No.27 of 2026, Balayapalli Police station, Tirupathi District, for the alleged offences punishable under Section 108 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023¹. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the ingredients of the offence under Section 108 of 'the BNS' are not substantiated in the complaint. He further submits that the allegations are false and concocted, and that the Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He prays that the proceedings be quashed. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the investigation is in progress and several witnesses are yet to be examined at this stage. Hence, the FIR cannot be quashed. Heard the learned counsel for the parties. Considering the entire aspect, it appears that the presence of the de-facto complainant is required to dispose of the matter. Issue notice to Respondent No. 2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner is
