01.	29.04.2026	<u>SS,J</u> <u>I.A.No.01 of 2026</u> This application is considered and allowed, permitting the Petitioner/Accused No.14 to proceed with the instant Criminal Petition without filing a certified copy of C.C.No.3 of 2021 on the file of the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Kurnool. <u>SS, J</u> <u>Crl.P.No.3563 of 2026</u> The present Petitioner was cited as Accused No.14 in the final charge sheet connected with Cr.No.53 of 2016 of Kurnool III Town Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 477-A read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860¹. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner is in no way connected with the alleged offences. He further submits that the Petitioner is unaware of the affairs of the society and therefore has not committed any crime. It is contended that the charge sheet against the Petitioner is liable to be quashed.

		The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the preliminary charge sheet was filed against 12 persons after thorough investigation, and upon completion of investigation, the final charge sheet was submitted against 17 accused persons. The Petitioner, being possessor of the property of the society, was cited as Accused No.14. Heard the learned counsel for the parties. To determine the issue before this Court properly, the presence of Respondent No.2 is required. Issue notice to Respondent No. 2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out notice on Respondent No. 2 and file proof thereof in the Registry. List the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026. <u>SS, J</u> <u>I.A.No.02 of 2026</u> This is an application seeking stay of all further proceedings, including the appearance of the Petitioner/Accused No.14 in C.C.No.3 of 2021 on the file of the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Kurnool. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it appears that the Petitioner was cited as Accused No.14. The Petitioner's personal appearance is not prima facie required in this	
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		case. Accordingly, petitioner personal appearance before the learned Trial Court in C.C.No.3 of 2021 on the file of the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Kurnool is dispensed with. It is made clear that, the Petitioner shall be represented through his counsel before the learned Trial Court and shall make his presence only when specifically required, by learned Trial Court including dates of framing of charge, examination under Section 313 Cr.P.C., and on the date of judgment. <u>SS, J</u> PRA	
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
