01.	29.04.2026	<u>SS,J</u> <u>I.A.No.01 of 2026</u> This application is considered and allowed, permitting the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 & 2 to proceed with the instant Criminal Petition without filing a certified copy of C.C.No.1255 of 2024 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam. <u>SS, J</u> <u>Crl.P.No.3575 of 2026</u> Petitioners are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 and 2 in C.C.No.1255 of 2024 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam, for the alleged offences punishable under Section 420 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860¹. It has been alleged that Petitioners were selling IPL cricket match tickets at higher rates. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the allegations in the FIR are false and concocted, and that the Petitioners never sold tickets for higher prices. It is further submitted that the material recorded during the course of

		investigation falsifies the prosecution's case. At this juncture, if the statements of available witnesses, particularly LWs.4 and 5, are taken to be true, the prosecution's case is not maintainable. Hence, the Petitioners pray that the proceedings be quashed. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that during investigation, incriminating material was collected against Petitioners regarding their alleged involvement in the offence. Therefore, the matter cannot be quashed at this stage. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, and considering the evidence collected by the police during the course of investigation, I think the matter requires detailed consideration. List the matter under the caption 'For Hearing', after Summer Vacation, 2026.
