01.	29.04.2026	<u>SS,J</u> <u>Crl.P.No.3573 of 2026</u> The Petitioner is arrayed as Accused in Cr.No.19 of 2025 of Tadikonda Police Station, Guntur District, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 316(5), 79 and 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023¹. Learned counsel for Petitioner submits that Petitioner is an agent of JK Education Consultancy, which provides admissions in MBBS courses abroad. He further submits that the allegations in the FIR are false and concocted, as there was an agreement between the Petitioner and the de-facto complainant for securing admission in an MBBS course abroad, but de-facto complainant herself flouted the conditions of the agreement and, having been involved in the breach, lodged a false case against the Petitioner. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that there are glaring materials in the FIR to substantiate the offences alleged against the Petitioner, the investigation is still in progress at this stage quashing is not possible.
