WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri VAMSI KRISHNA VARANASI, presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to QUASH the F.I.R. No.19 of 2025, on the file of the Station House Office, Tadikonda Police Station, Guntur District to the extent of 316(5) of BNSS-2023 and be pleased to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri VAMSI KRISHNA VARANASI, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public

Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following ORDER:

The Petitioner is arrayed as Accused in Cr.No.19 of 2025 of Tadikonda Police Station, Guntur District, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 316(5), 79 and 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023¹.

Learned counsel for Petitioner submits that Petitioner is an agent of JK Education Consultancy, which provides admissions in MBBS courses abroad. He further submits that the allegations in the FIR are false and concocted, as there was an agreement between the Petitioner and the de-facto complainant for securing admission in an MBBS course abroad, but de-facto complainant herself flouted the conditions of the agreement and, having been involved in the breach, lodged a false case against the Petitioner.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that there are glaring materials in the FIR to substantiate the offences alleged against the Petitioner, the investigation is still in progress at this stage quashing is not possible.

Heard the learned counsel for the parties. This matter cannot be disposed of without hearing the de facto complainant.
